All double rooms and junior suites at this Relais & Châteaux establishment have been decorated in red, black and white. Parquet floors, lacquered furniture and Philippe Starck beds lend the rooms structure and class. Mirrored corridors lead to generously-sized, bright, ultra-modern bathrooms, featuring Bulgari and Culti products.

There are two chalets situated next to the main building. The traditional architecture blends harmoniously with the contemporary style of the guest rooms and conference facilities. The themed suites, all of which are unique, raise the bar in terms of stylish living. Guests in the “Asia Suite” can enjoy an Asian touch, while those in the “Etoiles Suite” can gaze through a glass dome at the starry sky as they relax in the jacuzzi. If you require an extra room for your nanny, then the “Chalet Suite” is the one for you. In addition to an open fireplace, dressing room and marble bathroom it has two connecting rooms which can be booked as well if required.

Guests meet in the Bellevue Bar for an aperitif and make themselves comfortable in the black Le Corbusier armchairs to the sound of piano music before dinner. Culinary delights in a class of their own await our guests. The newly appointed head chef Urs Gschwend marries local, everyday cuisine with the finest of products. He loves Mediterranean cooking and lives out his affinity for Asian cuisine which blends in seamlessly with the Grand Hotel Bellevue’s philosophy. At the Grand Hotel Bellevue the emphasis in the Restaurant Coelho is on serving a “taster menu” for hotel guests, while the Restaurant Prado offers selected specialties “à-la-carte”.

“Le Petit Chalet” is a very special place: located on the Gstaad promenade in the Grand Hotel Bellevue park, this is a small chalet which seats 16 people. During the summer season you can enjoy grilled specialties, while in winter the favourites are fondue and raclette.

If you're keen to know more about the treasures in our wine cellar, you can take part in a wine tasting event in our romantic Carnotzet, a vaulted cellar containing more than 10,000 bottles of fine wines from all over the world. Enjoy the vast universe of wine with our sommelier, Raphael Tanner, and discover the pleasure of drinking truly exquisite wines.

One of the chalets houses the seminar wing which is directly connected with the main building. The seminar rooms are the perfect venue for meetings, conferences and seminars. All rooms are equipped with the latest technology and have access to the terrace, which offers spectacular, unobstructed views of the surrounding mountains. State-of-the-art seminar equipment is available onsite and includes telephone/video conferencing facilities and simultaneous translation services.

A further highlight: the Asian-style Bellevue Spa – an oasis of tranquillity covering more than 2,500 m². In the pool and sauna area you'll find an osmatic and herbal steam bath, lanconium, a salt and ice grotto, Finnish and bio sauna for total relaxation. And in the treatment rooms, also Asian in style with futon beds, freestanding tubs and dark natural stone, you can pamper yourself with facials, a Lomi Lomi Nui massage or a blossom bath.

The fitness area is equipped with state-of-the-art Technogym machines (including kinesis). Pilates sessions are held in the gym room next door. Private lessons can be arranged on request. Waterbeds and extremely comfortable Dedon loungers allow you to fully relax after your work-out. In summer, the large terrace with its view across the gentle rolling meadows of the Saanenland provides a perfect spot for sunbathing. After all this, you're sure to be in top form for your round of golf the following day, or for a walk to the picturesque Arnensee lake or the spectacular Geltenschuss waterfall.
